Please, format title, author(s), affiliation(s), text of the abstract, references, and 3–5 keywords according to this sample L^AT_EX file. The L^AT_EX file of the abstract (and the pdf created from this) should be submitted via email to `karlis@aueb.gr`, check also

for details. Avoid the use of figures in the one-page abstract. Indicate if you are interested in oral or the poster competition. The deadline for submitting the abstract is 28/01/2010.
